With all the Wine Tastings we begin with a Welcome Fizz before we taste five specially selected wines. Maureen will show you how to taste the wines like a pro, discuss some of the grape varieties, look at wine labels, and much more!

Private tastings are for 6 to 10 people.

The following **three tastings** include wines from around the world showcasing different grape varieties and blends.

Reds: Welcome Fizz, plus five red wines

Whites: Welcome Fizz, plus five white wines

Mixed: Welcome Fizz, plus two white, one rosé, and two red wines

The following **nine tastings** comprise wines from a particular country or region, showcasing different grape varieties and blends. Each tasting includes a welcome fizz, plus two white, one rosé, and two red wines.

Terms & Conditions

1. Private Tastings are for 6 to 10 people. If you require a Tasting for more than 10 people, please contact Maureen via email (info@thebeegarden.co.uk) in the first instance.
2. The minimum cost per Private Tasting will be 6 x the price per head, *even if fewer than 6 people attend*.
3. The total cost of the Tasting will be determined by the total number of participants indicated at the time of booking. If there are 'no shows' at the actual Tasting, no refund will be given for the 'no shows'. For example, if a booking is made for 10 participants, and only 8 attend, there will be no refund for the 2 not attending.
4. A Temporary Event Notice (TEN) is required for an unlicensed venue (such as a private home or community venue). The cost of a TEN (£21) may affect the overall event price. For an explanation of Temporary Event notices go to: <https://www.gov.uk/find-licences/temporary-events-notice>
5. To book an event you must be over 18 years of age and all attendees must also be over the age of 18. If Maureen suspects a guest is under the age of 18 then proof of age will be requested.
6. Finding a venue, and any booking and payment obligations, is the responsibility of the person booking the Tasting.
7. Other factors may affect the quoted price per person, such as mileage or if a specific wine is requested. Maureen will always work positively with clients to agree a mutual fee to suit all scenarios.
8. Maureen may request to visit the client and the venue prior to the event to check all requirements, access, room lay-out and so on.
9. Once an event is booked, any difference in the number of guests should be communicated to Maureen no later than seven working days prior to the event.
10. Maureen will provide and present the wines, unless otherwise agreed with the client. Glasses can be provided for up to 10 people, if required.
11. Food is not provided by Maureen.

Payment

1. A *non-refundable* 25% deposit of the total fee is required at the time of booking. Maureen will send you an Invoice. Payment is to be made by BACS. Your booking is not secure until the deposit is received.
2. The remainder of the total fee must be paid at least ten days before the event. Maureen will send you an Invoice. Payment is to be made by BACS.

Cancellation

1. If you cancel a Tasting *at any time* after the booking has been agreed, the deposit will not be refunded.
2. If you cancel a Tasting *more than ten days* before the Tasting and have paid the remainder of the fee, it (the remainder of the fee) will be refunded. However, Maureen will also request/retain the fee of the Temporary Event Notice (£21) if she has applied for one.
3. If you cancel a Tasting *ten days or fewer* before the Tasting and have paid the remainder of the fee, it (the remainder of the fee) will *not* be refunded. This is because wines will have already been purchased, and information leaflets printed. Maureen will also request/retain the fee of the Temporary Event Notice (£21) if she has applied for one.
4. Maureen reserves the right to cancel the Tasting if the remainder of the total fee is not received by the date indicated on the Invoice. The deposit is non-refundable.
5. If for any reason Maureen has to cancel the Tasting a full refund of the total fee, including the deposit, will be given.
